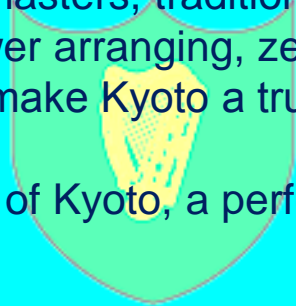
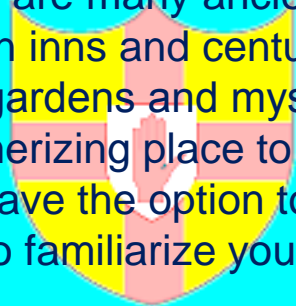
Shizuoka to Kyoto

A must see is the Genbaku Dome which is the only structure left standing at Ground Zero, now a memorial to the destructive nature of the bomb.

Hiroshima is a thriving city filled with shops, bars, restaurants where you will find its signature dish of Okonomiyaki – a savory pancake with noodles cooked on an iron plate usually in front of the customer. The dish can be found in almost every restaurant as it is a culinary delight that the people of Hiroshima are rightly proud of.

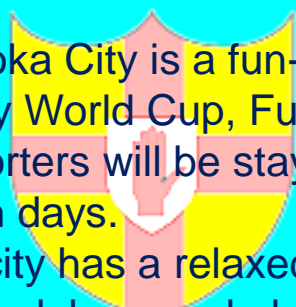
